

ORDINANCE NO. 03-23-02

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH GANLEY VILLAGE CDJRF FOR THE
PURCHASE OF A NEW 2023 DODGE DURANGO SUV, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Kirtland Hills ("Village") is in need of a new sport utility vehicle ("SUV") for use by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said SUV can be purchased at a lower cost from Ganley Village CDJRF ("Ganley"), with fleet pricing than through the DAS Cooperative Purchasing Program, and consequently the purchase should be made without competitive bids pursuant to the authority found in Article IV, Section 4.1(c) of the Kirtland Hills Village Charter.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF KIRTLAND HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ganley for the purchase of a new 2023 Dodge Durango SUV in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer, said contract not to exceed Thirty-Eight Thousand, Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$38,733.00).

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of this Village and for the further reason that the herein described vehicle is immediately necessary to protect the safety of the citizens of the Village of Kirtland Hills; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage.
