

ORDINANCE NO. 04-23-01

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE ESTABLISHED SALARIES AND HOURS OF WORK
OF VARIOUS OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF KIRTLAND HILLS
VILLAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF KIRTLAND HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the compensation of the Supervisor of Roads, Public Buildings and Lands shall be not less than \$2,530.90 bi-weekly and not more than \$2,821.00 bi-weekly as determined by the Mayor.

SECTION 2. That the compensation of the Assistant Supervisor of Roads, Public Buildings and Lands shall be not less than \$2,319.93 bi-weekly and not more than \$2,586.30 bi-weekly as determined by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. That after a two-year probationary period, the compensation of a Laborer shall not be less than \$2,143.49 bi-weekly and not more than \$2,317.22 bi-weekly as determined by the Mayor.

During the two-year probationary period, the compensation of a Laborer shall not be less than \$1719.92 bi-weekly and not more than \$2,143.49 as determined by the Mayor.

SECTION 4. That the compensation of a Public Service Assistant, Part-Time shall not be less than \$13.38 per hour and not more than \$21.51 per hour as determined by the Mayor.

SECTION 5. That the compensation of the Chief of Police shall be \$4,321.38 bi-weekly.

SECTION 6. That the compensation of the Police Lieutenant shall not be less than \$3,155.31 bi-weekly and not more than \$3,639.07 bi-weekly

SECTION 7. That the compensation of a Police Sergeant shall not be less than \$2,939.54 bi-weekly and not more than \$3,211.03 bi-weekly

SECTION 8. That the compensation of a full-time Police Officer shall be as follows:

Step #1 \$2,417.09 bi-weekly.

Step #2 \$2,524.96 bi-weekly commencing at the beginning of the pay period following completion of one (1) full year of service with Kirtland Hills Village.

Step #3 \$2,698.64 bi-weekly commencing at the beginning of the pay period following completion of two (2) full years of service with Kirtland Hills Village.

Step #4 \$2,884.74 bi-weekly commencing at the beginning of the pay period following completion of three (3) full years of service with Kirtland Hills Village.

Based upon prior experience and merit, the Mayor upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police, may waive the service time requirements relative to step advancements.

SECTION 9. That the compensation of a part-time Police Officer shall be not less than \$20.87 per hour and not more than \$23.19 per hour as determined by the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police who shall base his recommendation upon prior experience and merit of the individual.

SECTION 10. That the compensation of a full-time Administrative Assistant shall be not less than \$17.98 per hour and not more than \$26.88 per hour as determined by the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police.

SECTION 11. That the compensation of a part-time Police Clerk shall be not less than \$18.00 per hour and not more than \$20.00 per hour as determined by the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police.

SECTION 12. That Employees shall be eligible for additional compensation in the form of a year end bonus payable in December for extraordinary services rendered during the year. The awarding of a bonus shall be at the sole discretion of the Mayor, upon recommendation by the Chief of Police. Not more than a total of \$11,000.00 per year shall be distributed to members of the Police Department; not more than a total of \$5,000.00 per year shall be distributed to members of the Service Department; and not more than a total of \$2,500.00 per year shall be distributed to other employees.

SECTION 13. That the compensation of the Clerk Treasurer shall be in the sum of \$36.40 per hour.

SECTION 14. That the compensation of the above officers and employees shall be paid bi-weekly.

SECTION 15. That the wages and salaries of Assistant Supervisor of Roads, Laborers, Clerk Treasurer, Police Sergeant, full-time Police Officers, Administrative Assistants and part-time Police Officers are based upon a forty (40) hour work week. For hours worked in excess thereof, said employees shall be paid at time and one half.

SECTION 16. That the Chief of Police, Lieutenant of Police and Supervisor of Roads shall work such hours, but not less than forty (40) hours per week, as are necessary to perform the duties of their offices. They shall receive no additional compensation for hours worked in excess of forty (40) hours per week nor shall they receive compensatory time off without the prior written approval or authorization of the Mayor.

SECTION 17. That the compensation and salaries provided for in this Ordinance shall be effective as of December 17, 2022, except for the position of part-time Police Clerk, for which the compensation shall become effective April 22, 2023.

SECTION 18. That Ordinance No. 12-22-16 as well as any and all Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 19. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 20. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure needed for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Kirtland Hills, and for the further reason that immediate passage is necessary so as to provide the herein contained compensation for the officers and employees of the Village consistent with commitments made and shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force from and upon its passage.
