

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-22

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM, RELATIVE TO THE VILLAGE'S HART ROAD SLOPE STABILIZATION REPLACEMENT PROJECT, TO EXECUTE ALL AGREEMENTS AND CONTRACTS REQUIRED WITH REGARD THERETO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") Local Transportation Improvement Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Kirtland Hills Village is planning to make capital improvements to the Village Hart Road Slope Stabilization Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement identified is a priority need for Kirtland Hills Village and is a qualified project under the aforementioned OPWC Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF KIRTLAND HILLS, LAKE COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to apply to the Ohio Public Works Commission for funds necessary for the Village Hart Road Slope Stabilization Replacement Project.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into any and all contracts and agreements as may be necessary and appropriate to obtain financial assistance under the OPWC Program.

SECTION 3. That Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance constitutes an emergency in that the same provides for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Kirtland Hills and for the future reasons that the application to participate in the OPWC Local Transportation Improvement Program must be submitted forthwith; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
